

In-home Nursing

In association with your primary care physician, Sleepy Eye Area Home Health licensed nurses visit you right at home with an individualized plan of care that makes attending to your health a little easier. In addition, your in-home nursing professional can offer some assistance with the coordination of other health care support. During an in-home visit, your home health nurse may assist you with a variety of in-home services.
