Serving Western Colorado in Montrose & Delta Counties





The Program of All Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) model is centered on the belief that the well-being of seniors with chronic care needs and their families are better served in the community.

Senior CommUnity Care provides health care and supportive services enabling older adults to sustain independence and continue living in their home whenever possible. We are a service of Volunteers of America, a non-profit, faith-based organization.

The PACE Health Center

The PACE Health Center is an important part of Senior CommUnity Care. Seniors receive health care, nutritious meals and participate in activities with others so they can remain active, socialize and make new friends. Doctors, nurses and other health care professionals can deliver treatment and monitor a participant's health conveniently onsite.

Eligibility

Seniors are eligible for this program if they:

- Are 55 or older
- Live in the service area
- Meet State of Colorado criteria for Long Term Care Medicaid
- Can live safely at home with our services

Enrollment is EASY

Our Enrollment Specialist will meet with you and a family member or caregiver to explain the program. They will do an assessment of your eligibility and schedule a visit to our Center and a meeting with your doctor, nurses and other key staff. You will receive a medical evaluation and a custom care plan.

We complete the enrollment paperwork for you to become a participant. Enrollment is voluntary. You may disenroll at any time by notifying the Senior CommUnity Care of Colorado social worker.



Who Pays for this PROGRAM?

For seniors who are Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries and recipients of Supplemental Security Income Program (SSI) benefits, there is no premium or co-payments for the Senior Community Care of Colorado PACE program. For other Medicare beneficiaries, please call us to see how you may qualify.
