U.S. News awards the designation of Best Nursing Homes only to those communities that satisfy their rigorous, data-driven standards. In 2025, ratings were determined by nurse staffing, patient outcomes and whether nursing home routines included steps known to be effective in avoiding harm and improving health.

To be recognized as one of the 2025 U.S. News Best Nursing Homes, a nursing home must have been “high performing” in short-term rehabilitation, long-term care or both. Out of the 14,832 nursing homes evaluated, 2,836 (19%) met those criteria, of which 2,152 were high performing in short-term rehabilitation, 1,327 were high performing in long-term care and 643 were high performing in both.

The Preserve continues to be a trusted resource for families in Southwest Florida, not only through its compassionate care, but also through its collaborative approach.
