Anoka

Volunteers of America has been serving the community of Anoka and Anoka County in what was known as "Anoka Care Center." The Homestead at Anoka opened its doors on Feb. 26, 2013 and recently underwent a massive expansion, adding 65 independent living apartments and 20 memory support apartments. Our professional staff of over 300 employees proudly serves over 300 people daily, including 100 new short-term rehabilitation guests each month.



CARE CONFERENCES

Care conferences are held within 21 days of admission with the interdisciplinary team. During the care conference, there will be discussion on discharge planning, progress in therapy and other concerns. Care conferences are scheduled for 30 minutes and are normally held in the afternoon. Please inform your social worker if you need to schedule a care conference at a different time.

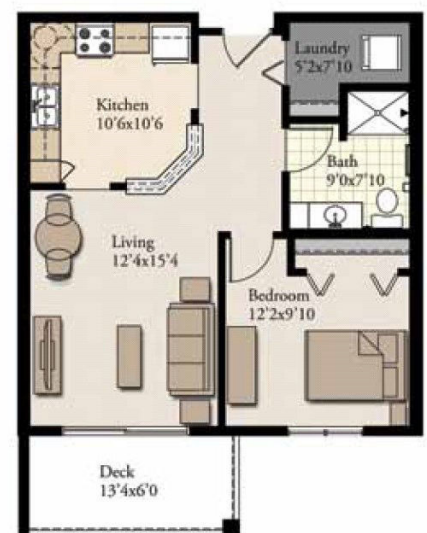

Much of your time here will involve therapy to maximize your full potential and to achieve optimal recovery and independence. Our therapists offer Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy in a fully equipped therapy gym. We offer specialized programs focusing on treating pain, edema, incontinence, cognition, cardiac conditions and balance in addition to general rehab and physical therapy. Therapy schedules are determined at time of evaluation and adjusted based on your individual needs.
