Valley Manor Care Center
Montrose, CO | Since 1981

Valley Manor Care Center was the beginning of the Volunteers of America presence on the Western Slope. Montrose was chosen as the location because it was centrally located and could work closely with the existing hospital, Montrose Memorial. Today, you still find 24-hour quality long-term care, respite, and hospice/end of life care at Valley Manor. In 1980, a secure memory care wing was added to serve those living with Alzheimer’s and other dementia related diseases. Physical, occupational, and speech therapies are available to all residents, short-term transitional patients, and out-patients through Montrose Rehabilitation Center, which was opened on the south side wing of the building in 1985.



Horizons Care Center
Eckert, CO | Since 1985

Horizons Care Center became part of the family when a local physician built and founded it for the Surface Creek communities of Cory, Austin, Eckert and Cedaredge. The nine acre campus offers long-term, respite, and end of life care with 24-hour nursing sevices. A comprehensive rehabilitation wing complete with therapy gym, outdoor enclosed patio and private rooms offers in-patient and outpatient physical, occupational and speech therapies. Independent living studio apartments and a trailer park for older adults are included on the property.



Home Health of Western Colorado
Montrose & Delta Counties | Since 2001



As the population grew, It became apparent that the region should add a home health component to its continuum of care aging services. Therefore, Home Health Care of Western Colorado was opened as a less expensive, more convenient, and effective way to receive care in the home compared to a hospital or long term care facility stay. Highly experienced skilled nurses are on call 24-hours/day, seven days a week, as well as home health aides, physical, occupational, and speech therapists to serve patient needs. Services offered include wound care, IV therapy, disease management, medication management, surgical aftercare and more. The program now serves clients in Montrose, Delta and Ouray County.

Senior Community Care
Program of All Inclusive
Care for the Elderly (PACE)
Montrose & Delta Counties
Since 2008

The PACE model is centered on the belief that the well-being of seniors with chronic care needs are better served by providing health care and supportive services that enable them to remain living in their home whenever possible. The PACE Day Center was opened as a physical location where medical and support services are provided in addition to individual and group social activities. Our program was one of the first in the country to receive a grant to begin services in a rural location and has since become a model for other rural PACE programs.



Senior CommUnity Meals
Montrose, CO | Since 2009

In 2009, Volunteers of America Senior CommUnity Meals took over an existing program and began operating the meals program in eight communities - an area covering 4,600 square miles. Volunteer drivers deliver meals to homebound, low-income seniors throughout the program area. While service areas and dining locations have changed over the years, the goal of the program continues to center around providing food for those who rely on these meals for sustenance, independence and contact with the outside community.
